

FLYING FIELD AT RISK

The committee have received a complaint from a Weeton Parish Councillor that members are flying too close to the village and that there is excessive noise from some models. We have been summoned to a meeting with the council to explain our actions. All members must ensure that they do not fly under any circumstances to the right of the hedge marker. Also if walkers are on the path you must not fly over their heads but you should ensure that you shorten your circuit until they have gone. **You must** also ensure that your models are not noisy and are under the maximum noise limit of 82 DBs.

If a member of the committee or another member tells you that you are flying in the wrong area, or that your model is noisy, do not take exception to this but "**Take it in good faith**"!

If members do not comply with this they **will** be brought in front of the committee for an explanation of their actions.

Remember that we could lose our superb flying site if we upset our neighbours!
